### Summary of the unit

This unit focuses on the skills needed to independently plan, design, manufacture and assess dental restorations (~~reconstructions~~).

The trainee shall know the various preparation modes and ~~shall~~ examine the working documents at his disposal. On the basis of the material data, ~~the trainee shall assess consider advise the client on~~ the specific features and the biocompatibility of the work material considered for use.

The trainee shall be familiar with tooth morphology as well as with the occlusal and ~~opposing~~ relationship and ~~shall be~~ able to recognise the specific occlusal features of the patient.

The trainee shall be aware of the construction requirements associated with dental restorations and shall also be familiar with the various ~~fixing systems (e.g. adhesive, cementing)~~ and their characteristics as well as with the consequences of inappropriate or misapplied stress.

The trainee shall possess the necessary skills to plan, design, manufacture and assess ~~the quality of custom-made,~~ functional and aesthetic restorations that ~~shall~~ require the use of appropriate production technologies and relevant ~~dental work~~ materials.

The trainee shall be well aware of their responsibility ~~to the patient providing a fault free device should a faulty device impair the masticatory function and should a misfortunate aesthetic shaping seriously reduce the quality of life of the patient.~~
